Purpose: Promote Personal Giving in Personal Outreach to Others.

Procedure: • Complete all requirements by NZLTC Convention.

- At the convention, submit all individuals completing Stitching/Sewing on the **Challenge Submission Form** to registration by **<DEADLINE>** - **See <NZLTC DEADLINE CALENDAR> for Important Cutoff Dates**

Rules:

1. This event is open to all Participants.
2. The participant shall make a Handmade 'Cuddle Buddy' such as a Seahorse, Bear, Pillow OR CrossStitch Hanging- Primarily made of clothe materials with minimum size 35cm long by 35cm wide.
3. The participant must complete at least Two (2) Stitching/Sewing Items to be given to a non-Christians.
4. The Stitching/Sewing item must include at least One (1) Scripture verse on surface of gift..
5. Clothe Label attached must include: a]- Participant Name(s) & Age(s), b]- Congregation & #, c]- Title of Item.

Awards: Gold, Silver or Bronze will be awarded for completion of this event.
